- **Experienced Financial Manager:** Butler has spent the past nine years as an internal auditor and financial manager for the University of Minnesota.

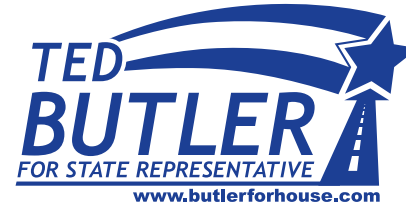

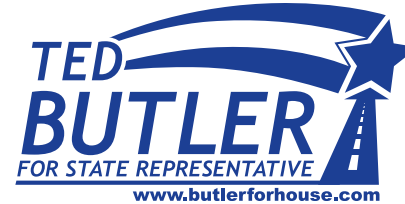

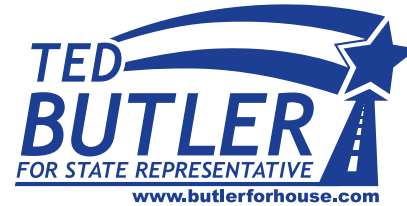
